Dear Parents

Our children from Primary 7 have been involved in six workshops with BEAM Creative Network, funded by the Loughshore Family Action Project, as part of our internet safety work in school. They have discussed the advantages and disadvantages of social media and looked at a variety of ways of keeping safe when using the internet. They have produced their own DVD to highlight issues which arose during their workshops. On **Thursday 15 June** we will be launching the DVD and holding an information session for parents on internet safety.
