SchoolMoney – On-line payment system

Car Park - HEALTH AND SAFETY

Water Bottles

Children can bring their own water bottles to school. Please make sure they are named and filled up each morning.

Food Allergies – school meals

Forms are available from the school cook, Mrs M Neill, should your child develop or present with food allergies which require notification to our school canteen staff.

Medical Information

Please keep the school informed of any recently diagnosed allergies or other medical conditions. If you require a Medical form, please contact Mrs Watson.

Please ensure the school has at least three up to date contact numbers for your child should you need to be contacted during school hours and while your child is travelling home on the school bus.

Parents/Guardians can apply if your son or daughter is in full-time education and if you are in receipt of one of the following benefits:-

Income Support; Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance; Income Related Employment and Support Allowance; Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit; Child Tax Credit or Working Tax Credit with an annual taxable income of £16,190 or less; Universal credit and have net household earnings not exceeding £14,000 per year.
