Good morning P6s,


I hope you are all enjoying your time at home, it is still strange not being able to get into school to see everyone. I really miss seeing you and listening to your stories, especially on Monday mornings!

Over the Easter holidays it was very different not being able to go out anywhere.


I've been doing a lot of gardening and playing a lot more with my dogs Anya and Toby and of course my three daughters!
